

Patrick Middleton Scholarship

This Scholarship was established in loving memory of Patrick Middleton, a man of unwavering faith, who committed incredible amounts of time to the people of St. Cecilia Parish. Funds for this scholarship are made possible through the generosity of parishioners of St. Cecilia and friends of Patrick Middleton.

Patrick Middleton grew up in Port Orchard, Washington. After graduating from high school, he attended the University of Washington and received a law degree from Gonzaga University. He practiced law, ultimately becoming a partner in his law firm. Family was most important to him and he made sure that his three children had many life experiences, enjoyed sports, had a good education, and attended college. Patrick had a deep faith and for many years he taught RCIA. He came to realize education and teaching, to be his true calling. He pursued and achieved a master's degree in theology and intended to teach in Catholic elementary and secondary schools. He began to substitute teach in a Catholic high school in Seattle and felt that he could have an impact on the faith development of high school youth . This scholarship continues his work by helping to support an opportunity for any student from Bainbridge Island or those from surrounding communities affiliated with St. Cecilia Parish to learn and grow in a Catholic high school environment that integrates academics with faith values.

Scholarship Details

Applicants must be an eighth grade student who meets the following criteria as appropriate:

- **Will be attending a Catholic high school in the fall of 2018**
- **Resident of Bainbridge Island (Student does not have to be Catholic.)**
- **If not a resident of Bainbridge Island, attends St. Cecilia Catholic School , the PREP Program, or is an active member of St. Cecilia Parish**

Awards are based on successful academic promise, leadership, and school, community, and church involvement. One \$2000 scholarship will be awarded. Applications should be turned into the St. Cecilia Parish Office by May 1, 2018. Applications will be evaluated and candidates will be notified in June. The award will be applied to the student's tuition in August.
